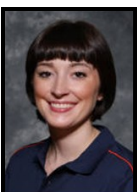
Kaddie Mahoney Platt is in her 16th season as head volleyball coach for Houston Baptist University. Last season, HBU enjoyed its second 20+ win season since beginning the transition back to NCAA Division I. During the 2007 campaign, while achieving her 400th career victory, she led the Huskies to a 26-3 record in their first year back in the NCAA Division I ranks. Platt, who holds a 447-115 record as a head coach, created an NAIA volleyball power house in her first 12 seasons at HBU, leading the Huskies to eight conference championships, five regional titles and six appearances in the NAIA National Tournament. The Huskies enjoyed their most successful season in 2002 when HBU was the NAIA national championship runner-up, garnering Platt National Coach of the Year and National Tournament Coach of the Year honors. Platt has coached 51 All-Conference players with 17 of those going on to receive All-America honors. She has coached eight conference players of the year and four conference setters of the year. She also places great importance on academics and has coached 81 academic All-conference honorees with 15 of those progressing to achieve academic All-America status. In 2007, the Huskies earned an AVCA Team Academic Award, one of 70 NCAA Division I programs to be recognized for academic excellence by maintaining at least a 3.30 GPA on a 4.0 scale.



Nicole Westerterp is entering her second season as graduate assistant coach at HBU, returning to her alma mater where she is one of the most-decorated athletes in program history. After transferring from Nebraska in 2003, she became a four-time All-American, All-region and All-Red River Athletic Conference selection for the Huskies. She was also named Red River Athletic Conference player of the year in 2004 and 2006 and voted to the national All-tournament team in 2003 after leading HBU to a conference titles in 2003 and 2006. Westerterp earned region player of the year honors in 2006 and was also tabbed region front row specialist of the year, and made the region All-tournament team. She was named region freshman of the year in 2003. In addition to her many accolades, Westerterp ranks as the Huskies' all-time leader in kills (1,954), blocks solo (345) and blocks assisted (496), and ranks third in service aces (212). She was inducted into the HBU Sports Hall of Honor in 2008. Following her career, she became the assistant coach at Lee College and was the head coach for Texas Eastside Volleyball Club's 15 & 16's team in 2008 and 2009. She has also head coached for Houston Juniors in 2010 and 2011. Westerterp has assisted with camps at HBU, Rice and Texas. Westerterp, a Beaumont, Texas native, is working on her MBA having graduating from HBU with a degree in kinesiology and business in 2007.



Jenny Andrew was named assistant volleyball coach at Houston Baptist University in March 2011, joining the Huskies after spending one season as an assistant coach at the University of Virginia, where she served as recruiting and offensive coordinator. She previously coached the 17 and under team for Austin Juniors Volleyball Club, one of the top three club programs in the nation, qualifying for nationals twice and receiving the 2010 Coach of the Year Award. She also worked for Nike as a marketing specialist. During her four-year career at the University of Texas, the 6-foot-2 setter made three NCAA Tournament appearances, including the Sweet 16 in 2004 and the Elite Eight in 2006. She was named most valuable player in 2006, was a Big 12 Academic All-Conference and Commissioner's Honor Roll selection and served on the Student-Athletic Advisory Council. Andrew was invited to try out for the United States National Team and trained with the USA Volleyball A2 Team. Andrew graduated from Texas in 2007 with a Bachelor of Science degree in sport management with a minor in business foundations. She is a Houston-area native, and was a standout on the court at Kingwood High School.
